


	Day of the month	1 st Passover	Messiah's Passover
13 th	Passover lamb selected	Exo 12: 3 Male lamb without defect.	Mat 21: 1 – 11; John 12: 1 – 13 Messiah comes to Jerusalem to people singing "Hosanna"
14 th	Passover lamb slaughtered between evenings on the 14 th	Exo 12: 6 – 11 Passover lamb slaughtered between the evenings, blood painted on the doorposts, lamb roasted and eaten.	Mark 15: 25; John 19:14; John 18: 28 Messiah ate Passover with his disciples. Messiah impaled on the same day ("Hebrew day"), Wednesday that year.
15 th	1 st day of Unleavened Bread	Lev 23: 5 – 6 Starting day of Unleavened bread day feast. Also day Israelites escaped from Egypt.	Mark 15: 42 Annual Sabbath so people resting – Thursday.
16 th			Mark 16: 1; Luke 23: 56 Normal working day; spices bought, and women prepare the spices for the body – Friday.
17 th			John 20: 1; Mark 16: 2 People rest and Messiah rises at the end of the weekly Sabbath day.
18 th	Jonah's story		Mat 12: 40; 16: 4 Sign of Jonah.



2. Levitical → Melchizedek

- ▶ *Luke 1: 5 – genetic heritage of JTB of his Levitical roots
- ▶ *Lev 10: 8 to 9 – priests must not have wine: JTB didn't drink wine
- ▶ Mal 3: 1 - messenger to prepare the way
- ▶ Mal 4: 5 – Elijah the prophet turning hearts
- ▶ John 3: 30 – Messiah must ↑, JTB must ↓
- ▶ Mat 11: 10 to 13 – confirming prophesy of Malachi
- ▶ Heb 7: 11 – 16 Lev to Melchi






3. Passover - spiritual

- ▶ **Leaving behind our lives of slavery to sin, to inherit a life of spiritual freedom in Messiah**
- ▶ John 1: 29 - "See the Lamb that takes away the sin of the world."
- ▶ **1Pe 1:19** - But with the **precious blood of Messiah, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot**: was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was revealed in these last times for you,
- ▶ Rev 5:6 - And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood **a Lamb as it had been slain...**
- ▶ Rev 5:9 - And they sung a new song, saying, You are worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for you were slain, and **have redeemed us to God by your blood** out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;
- ▶ Gal 4: 3 - In the same way when we were children we were in slavery under the elemental forces of the world. When the time came to completion, Elohim sent his son, born of a woman, born under the law, to redeem those under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons.


Why should we keep Passover?
